PREVENTING BICYCLE THEFT

REGISTER YOUR BIKE!



Registering your bicycle couldn't be easier and is a key step in being reunited with your bike in the event that it is stolen.
Follow these 3 easy steps!

- 1. Gather the make, model, colour & approx. value of your bicycle
- 2. Identify the serial number on your bicycle
- 3. Register your bike online for free with Project529.com
- 4. If you'd like to register in person, registration stations can be searched at the website as well.

PROTECT YOUR BIKE!

- Take pictures of your bike, paying special attention to any marks, stickers, or upgrades that make it unique & identifiable.
- Use a high quality lock and ensure it fits through the wheel and frame.
 - If you can, bring your bike inside at night.

Close The Window of Opportunity

As the temperatures slowly start to rise, it's tempting to throw open the windows and let the fresh air in after a long winter hibernation. Follow these



helpful tips below to prevent any window-related property crime.

- Only open windows in a room you are currently occupying, and close them on your way out
- Good quality window locks should be installed and used on all windows
- Remove any ladders or stools from your yard while not in use that could allow access to an open window by an intruder
- Anchor any outdoor storage boxes an intruder may use to gain access to a higher area such as a deck or window
- Don't forget about sliding and screen doors! Lock the door when not in



use and draw the curtain when you are not at home

Keep an eye out for your neighbours and they will keep an eye out for you!
